Thank you to the local businesses in the village, whose contributions to advertising make it possible for us to produce this programme.





ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

Didsbury Festival is organised by a team of intergenerational volunteers from Didsbury Community Association (DCA) - a Charitable Incorporated Organisation No.1156857. The DCA has run the Didsbury Festival for 43 years, as well as Didsbury's Christmas carols and lights for 15 years.

This year the Festival will be hosted by Peter Chapman, to make sure all visitors are kept informed of the events in the park throughout the day.

The Festival begins with a procession that leaves St. Catherine's school at 11am and travels through the village down to Didsbury Park. The procession includes children from schools and groups from the local area including Broad Oak Primary School, Didsbury C of E School, Beaver Road Primary School, Moor Allerton School, Cavendish Road School, St. Catherine's RC Primary and the 5th Manchester Boys Brigade.

Didsbury Festival has always supported local charities to raise funds for great causes. This year we'll see stallholders from the Women's Institute, Blood Cancer UK, Tools for Self-Reliance, the Woodland Trust, alongside other charities, food vendors, businesses, schools, and community groups.

In 2024 our Funfair will be returning to Didsbury Park (Thanks to Scott Harrison and his Team) alongside the main Festival. Expect whizzing waltzers and bumper cars, and smaller rides for the youngest in the family.

This year we have nominated a junior committee to help the older committee! The junior members are as follows: Isobel Harrison, Harrison Brough, Taylor Brough, Maisie Robins.

We are so proud to be bringing younger members on board who are passionate about the history of the festival and really embedded in supporting the community. Look out for where they will be in the years to come !

Whilst they can often be spotted in the fair - They will also be wearing the Festival high vis - or helping in certain areas. please give them a high five if you see them, there enthusiasm for creating a memorable day for the community is second to non.



PARADE ROUTE



MORE ... ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

The Didsbury Community Association is a charity that is run by local residents and supported by many long-term members of the wider Didsbury community.

For all the incredible years we have been running, we have seen some significant change. Like many businesses, charities and communities nobody would ever of thought we would be faced with anything like the Covid 19 pandemic - obviously meaning we had 2 years where we were unable to put the Festival on.

Even though the pandemic seems long ago - we have certainly seen the fallout from the pandemic directly impact our Charity. Whilst we were very much focussed on charity stalls at the Festival - many of these charities are struggling themselves with donations and volunteers and more and more are struggling to man stalls themselves. Not only do we continue to support the charities themselves but we have also had to adapt to support the community in different ways and have now begun supporting local Didsbury business's and independents more and more, as it is clear they need the help just as much as local charities do.

As we are all experiencing the current cost of living crisis - this has truly affected some of our running costs too. The Festival costs us now circa £12,000. We have seen the costs of insurance, licenses, toilets, amenities, and services rocket. This has meant we have also had to find different ways to raise funds to support the rising costs whilst trying to keep costs low for the stall holders and the community visiting us on Festival day.

We not only support the Festival but hold an Annual Gala to raise money, where once again our fabulous community of shops, bars and restaurants support us with donations of raffle prizes etc - without the support of all of these and our fabulous stall holders we wouldn't be able to continue. However even this year the Gala did not raise enough money to cover even half of our running costs.

We are focussed on this years Festival and the coming years of Festivals and will continue to adapt and diversify so that we can continue to deliver a successful Festival for the community, supported by the community and run by the community.


